2. Student shows good stewardship of their time and talent.
3. Student must be in good behavioral standing.

Application Process:

- Obtain application from school Advancement & Admissions Office or online at www.ncsweb.org
- Complete application.
- Obtain a short letter of recommendation from a parent, teacher, or someone for whom you volunteer.
- Write a brief essay on the topic "A volunteer is. . . ."
- Submit completed application along with letter of recommendation and essay by March 15 to the Advancement & Admissions Office, 93 East Main Street, Norwalk, OH 44857.
- Each application will be reviewed by a committee of FCEDO volunteers and the FCEDO staff.
